Parking Registration

Transportation

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Check-in will begin at 7:30am on Saturday, November 8, 2025. **ALL PLAYERS MUST GO THROUGH THE CHECK-IN PROCESS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THEIR JERSEYS (UNLESS THEY HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED THEIR JERSEY DURING THE HAPPY HOUR).** Players must have already filled out the online waiver, or fill in a paper waiver during check-in. Online waiver registration will close on Friday night.

Intermediate and Recreational Division matches kick-off at 9:00am and run until the Final at 1:45pm. Competitive Division matches kick-off at 10:30am and run until the Finals at 2:15pm.

Note that online waivers will close on the night of Friday, November 7, to allow for time to create physical rosters.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Match Format:

- Each match will be 22 minutes in length
- Each match will have a 7v7 format, with six field players and one goalie to a side
- **A minimum of two female players from each team must be on the field at all times (this may include a goalkeeper)**
- A minimum of five players must be present at the start of the match in order to prevent a forfeit
- Each team is guaranteed a minimum of three group stage matches
- All Competitive Teams will make the Playoffs; Top 12 Teams in the Recreational and Intermediate Divisions will make the Playoffs

How will playoffs work?

Our goal is for every company to have the absolute best experience possible and play as many evenly matched games as possible with teams around their skill level.

As a result, our playoff format may be slightly different than what you have seen in other tournaments, and is designed to maximize the number of teams able to make playoffs within the field space available.

Competitive Division:

- All teams make the playoffs. Top two teams receive a bye to the semifinals
- Quarterfinal Round sees 6th place v. 3rd place and 4th place v. 5th place
- Winners will face off against the 1st and 2nd place teams in the semifinals

Intermediate Division:

- All 3 First Place teams and Best Remaining 3 Teams based on overall points (regardless of Group) advance to the Upper Playoffs (Poetry Cup)
- Next 6 teams based on overall points (regardless of Group) advance to the Lower Playoffs (Service Cup)
- Bottom 2 teams overall (13th and 14th place teams), based on overall points (regardless of Group) are eliminated

Recreational Division:

- All 3 First Place teams and Best Remaining 3 Teams based on overall points (regardless of Group) advance to the Upper Playoffs (Challenge Cup)
- Next 6 teams based on overall points (regardless of Group) advance to the Lower Playoffs (Friendship Cup)
- Bottom 2 teams overall (13th and 14th place teams), based on overall points (regardless of Group) are eliminated

Summarized Match Rules:

- **Slide-tackling is strictly prohibited.**
- Substitutions will be made “on-the-fly” from half-field, meaning that players do not need the referee’s acknowledgement to make a substitution (unless it’s the goalkeeper)
- Playoff matches, if tied, will go directly to penalty kicks (3 per team)
- Please refer to the full 2025 Miami SCORES Cup Rules for more details

Team/Player Equipment:

- **All players must wear the jersey provided to them at check-in.**
- **All players must wear shinguards.**
- **Matches will be played on grass fields; therefore, cleats are suggested.**
- Each team is expected to bring any necessary goalkeeper equipment.
- Game balls will be provided— teams do not have to bring additional balls.

OTHER IMPORTANT FAQs

Community Event:

The Miami SCORES Cup is an open event to the community— any friends, family members, or colleagues are more than welcome to join as spectators!

Food & Beverages:

With the support of our sponsors, like Starbucks and Coke Florida, **Miami SCORES will provide water, sports drinks, a light breakfast, lunch and snacks throughout the day. Lunch is provided for all participating players and volunteers, and if there is any extra, guests of players are welcome to join in.** *To reduce our impact on the environment, we request that players deposit bottles into appropriate recycling bins.*

Prizes & Giveaways:

The winners of the Miami SCORES Cup will receive eternal glory and a trophy, which they can show off in their office until the 2026 SCORES Cup.

All SCORES Cup players will receive a complimentary Unilever self-care package and a complimentary 3-day pass to access any of Equinox’s fitness studios on the dates of November 5, 6

and 7. Only players who have signed the waiver by November 5th will be registered for this benefit. Players do not need to do anything to sign up for the 3-day Equinox pass, they can simply show up to an Equinox facility and their name will be on the list.

Volunteers:

All referees, volunteers and tournament staff are professionals supporting the SCORES Cup.

Please treat them with respect and gratitude for spending their Saturday ensuring that our Cup is enjoyable for all players. Special thanks to Concacaf, NBC Universal, Telemundo, First Horizon Bank and Starbucks for sending a team of volunteers to support!

Photos:

Two volunteer photographers will be taking team photos and action shots during the matches. These photos will be available in due time after the Cup.

Tents:

Teams are allowed to bring tents, but setup will be first come first serve and all tents must be no larger than 10x10 as per FIU's regulations.

No alcohol will be allowed at the Cup.

Facilities:

Restrooms will be available at both fields.

First Aid:

Certified Athletic Trainers from Fox PT will be available throughout the tournament to take care of all medical needs.

Weather:

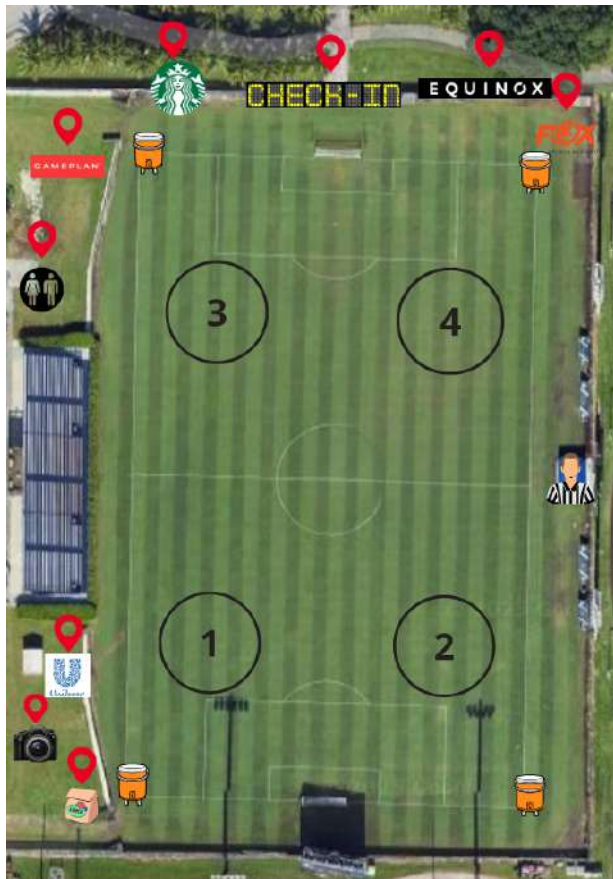
The tournament will proceed, rain or shine.
